Short Description

The course will introduce the student to Modern Standard Arabic (MSA) which is used by Arabic speakers around the world as a formal language, used for reading, writing and formal circumstances (for example: the News or varied formal settings).

The course aims to teach the basic grammar rules, providing a vocabulary which will allow the students to comprehend short texts dealing with daily life, media, literature, poetry, Quran and more.

The course's vision includes providing the student with the ability of oral expression in MSA and listening skills.

A variety of learning tools will be used- news sites, online encyclopedias, songs, films, speeches as well as a variety of written sources. In addition, the students will lead active conversation in the language according to the learning progress.

Final grade components

Minor assignments: **written and Oral Quizzes**- 18%

Midterm: **in class exam**- 15%

Final requirement: **in- class exam**- 55%

Participation, class assignments and attendance- 12%
