Short Description	
<p>This course serves as an introduction to the field of psychology. It will provide a survey of most of the common topics in psychology, including: human development, learning & memory, intelligence, psychopathology, and others. The course will focus on both theory and research in each area, as well as how it applies to everyday life.</p>	
Final grade components	
<p>Homework assignments: There will be five short homework assignments over the semester related to the readings. 35% of the course grade.</p> <p>Final requirement: Final paper on a current topic in psychology. The paper will be 10-12 double-spaced pages (2500-3000 words). Submission dates are set by the university and the Liberal Arts program and must be respected. 50% of the course grade</p> <p>Participation: Participation is based on Perusall score. 15% of course grade</p>

<p>Attendance is mandatory. Students are permitted a maximum of three unauthorized absences without penalty. Any additional absences will affect the final grade and may result in failure of the course.*</p>

<p>Plagiarism is taken extremely seriously.
